I agree with points others have raised on the proposed route for quarrying at Bromley Farm but I wish to keep my objections concise for clarity. I am delighted there is now recognition that Carr Hill Road is an unsuitable route but my two prime concerns regarding the now proposed route via the notoriously bad Sovereign Junction is as follows:- I challenge slow laden forty odd ton trucks trying to turn a quick right followed by a sharp swift left turn into Homefirth Road on a fast paced junction will be a recipe for hold ups and will force even more drivers to choose alternative Carr Hill Road, Carr Lane, Heater Lane and Cross Lane to avoid delays at the Sovereign Junction these will become even busier rat runs. There have been several nasty accidents because of this already this year alone and it's only still February! My other concern is who is going to police the HGVs not using Carr Hill Road? At present there is a restriction on heavy vehicles travelling West to East on Carr Hill Road but I frequently witness this rule violated. After nearly 2 years of ongoing uncertainty with negotiations on this application I do hope all those concerned come to the sensible conclusion that this proposal cannot go ahead.
