| <p>I have noted the revised route to be taken by the articulated lorry drivers following objections from residents of Carr Hill Road. This is an improvement only if the new route is adhered to by the drivers. What measures are in place to deter the drivers from taking the easiest route, i.e. along Carr Hill Road? If there are no penalties then the new route will be disregarded.</p> <p>I submit that whichever route is used, the imposition of so many very heavy vehicles on already overcrowded, overused roads is unacceptable. To allow these lorries at all will impact residents with noise and dirt all day and every day except on Sundays and leading to health issues. There are also pedestrians, cyclists and horse riders as well as children at the nearby primary school. Our roads are extra hazardous, having inadequate pavements and bearing the impact of more housing development in the area. In Carr Hill Road we already see many heavy articulated vehicles in addition to local traffic. It is my view that these extra lorries are completely unacceptable. Wavin may have mineral mining rights, but it does not have the right to inflict misery and extra hazards on local residents and the company should be advised as such.</p> |     |
