I object for the following reasons: Barnsley rd does not have a made footpath along the whole length and forces the public to cross the road, an additional 120 trucks travelling up and down will add additional significant risk to the public and cyclists; Carr Hill rd already has restrictions for large vehicles but these restrictions are regularly abused now so I have no confidence in trucks not using this as a cut through. The Sovereign junction is dangerous and needs traffic control measures despite what happens with this application. Noise and air pollution from dust particles and fuel emissions will adversely impact the quality and potentially the health and wellbeing of local residents because of the size and duration of the operation. I do not see any advantage to or for the local community with this quarry, conversely it has the potential to decrease the value of property, increase road safety concerns, and adversely impact on the quality of lives in Uppercumberworth.
