<p>In respect of this planning application my objections are as follows; As well as the air and noise pollution/reduced air quality caused by the proposed number of vehicles accessing and egressing the site and using the local highways there will be a number of potentially serious road safety risks.</p> <p>The proposed route and times of use will have a significant impact on school traffic and pedestrians attending Cumberworth C of E School, twice daily on school days. (especially at the Star Public House Junction).</p> <p>The 'pavement' along Barnsley Road towards the Sovereign Junction is narrow and poorly maintained, barely single file in places. The safety and enjoyment of pedestrians using this pathway will hardly be enhanced by the addition of further fast moving heavy vehicles.</p> <p>The increase in heavy lorries utilising the Sovereign Junction will result in more hazards on a junction already struggling to accommodate the present level of usage. To avoid the increased congestion of the Sovereign Junction people will inevitably cut down from Barnsley Road onto Carr Lane, exiting across, or onto the main road again at the Carr Lane/Cross Lane Junction, which is already notorious as an accident black spot. The health and safety of people walking, cycling, horse riding or living on this 'rat run' route will be compromised even more than it is already.</p> <p>I seriously suggest a radical rethink of this proposed development.</p>
