The grouting of voids at ground level is proposed for the following new structures – canopies, footbridge, and subway extension at Huddersfield Station. This is for groundworks with no interventions to the listed structures.

The report states that works are not expected to generate significant vibration or any cosmetic damage to buildings. Condition surveys are proposed to Huddersfield Station and the two warehouses to the north of the station platforms prior to the work and this is acceptable as any unexpected damage can be assessed and rectified on completion.
