<p>I understand this is the first step in getting planning permission for a further development. My objections to this planning application as as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- a previous planning permission stated that the exposed cliff in the quarry should be left undisturbed - filling in the quarry would go against this- the traffic bringing infill to the site would bring considerable disturbance to residents in the vicinity - especially noise and fumes- the road in the area are not suitable for lorries bringing the infill materials, being too narrow for cars/lorries to pass easily. The roads have already been badly damaged by lorries from a near-by quarry. The edges of the roads are crumbling where these lorries have driven on them- some residents in are area are on well/spring water. Consideration needs to be given to any effect on these supplies eg contamination.- this is green belt, bordering on open moorland - the permission being sought is not in keeping with the landscape.- there is the probability of gases being given off from the site over the coming years
