<p>We are very worried about the impact this will have on our spring water. In the past we have suffered contamination from the quarry affecting our ability to feed livestock and water to our house. The applicant has a history of breaching regulations and we are very concerned that we will suffer issues if this is allowed to happen. Also the amount of heavy vehicles on the road has already breached the permitted allowed. Cycling and walking on the narrow roads to the quarry is already dangerous. Allowing this application will increase the already excess use of quarry vehicles. The road is not wide enough to safely pass in places. Should this be allowed our farm animals and our drinking water will be at risk. We are concerned that the Environment Agency reply has not taken account of the spring water supply and ask that the re-look at their response in relation to this? Historical contamination can only get worse with any type of infill, let alone what this applicant might decide to try and use.</p>
