<p>We strongly object to the amendments to this planning application due to the following; Our house both looks onto this site, and is only a field away. This means the noise level from any crushing machine is audible from our property, it will be extremely noisy, with vibrations felt within our house. We already feel vibrations, and hear the noise from Windy Ridge Quarry on a daily basis. This is of great disturbance to us. This would effect our health, living conditions &amp; privacy.</p> <p>It will also have a great effect on the environment, affecting the treeline, wildlife, landscape &amp; character.</p> <p>Previously, the proximity of our property to this site has not been taken into consideration in any planning approval. We could both see this site, and hear the noise when it was previously quarried.</p> <p>Whitegate rd. &amp; up to Barebones rd. are not physically capable to provide safe use of HGV vehicles. The whole length of this road, needs resurfacing NOW! with a large section not even fit to walk on, with verges crushed by passing waggons.</p> <p>We attended the previous planning application meeting in 2001 for this site. The applicant, The Simpson Brothers ignored virtually all the planning rules which were passed at this time. The quarrying was continued by different ownership, who tried to over quarry the boundaries, which were passed in 2001. They were working up to 7days a week, from 7am-21.00hrs, disregarding any planning conditions. No-one from the council policed this activity. It was also stipulated in 2001, to re-instate any quarry faces to a safe &amp; stable condition, which has NOT been carried out to this date!</p>
