Thank you for sending me the information. As a user of the spring water system we are very concerned about this planning application being approved. My land is adjacent to the quarry and I have examined the area and can already see that existing quarrying works has got down to the water table. As can be witnessed by the green moss growing over the underground reservoir. It is for this water well that the spring water comes from. As this is already exposed any landfill going onto it will undoubtedly contaminate the water. Waste infill can contain anything from builders waste which can have asbestos in it. There is no way that a guarantee can be given that this water source will not be contaminated.

Past history of the applicants can be traced to Lockwood waste site and the costs and contamination that occurred here is terrifying.

Please do not allow an environmental potential disaster to go ahead and destroy our water supply.
