Dear Fazana Tabasum

The spring water which Lower Woodhouse Farm uses comes from an under ground reservoir (the drift) which is under the quarry and our field which is adjacent to the quarry. On page 9 of the Assessment you can see that Lower Woodhouse Farm uses water for Domestic and general Farming. The drift that this relates to is the one I have explained about on several occasions. You can also see that the drift is Licensed, number 2/27/10/081. This is for domestic and general farm use. As a child my husband has been up the tunnel which leads to the underground reservoir (the drift). Part way up the tunnel there is a stone wall and behind this is the reservoir. The walls are constructed of large square stones. This opens up into a large catchment area which spans under the quarry and under our field.

We are aware of most of the information used in the Risk Assessment as it has been published before on previous planning applications.

In the quarry you can see the hole has been dug down too deep and has now exposed the the water table. Any tipping down into this hole would potentially contaminate our supply. How would Kirklees manage the checking of any tipping's that would be brought onto the site?

This water is still used at the farm for Domestic and General farming use. Me and my husband bring water home to drink.

Dear Farzana

I am writing to let you know that Lower Woodhouse Farm, uses the spring water for household and agricultural purposes.

This water comes from the underground reservoir that is under the fields at Lower Woodhouse Farm and Woodhouse Quarry. Also my husband brings down the spring water from the farm for drinking.

This water supply is over 200 years old that we are aware of. In the summer months we notice a severe drop in the amount of water

especially after the last bore hole was put in on Cartworth Moor.
