



PHASE DESCRIPTION

Phase 2 comprises work within the north-western area of the quarry. Existing areas of existing lowland heathland will be stripped (circa 0.1m depth) and the soil placed into temporary storage bunds (circa 2metre high) as indicated. Stone stripped from the operational area for re-sale will be placed away from other site works and the landform adjusted to achieve proposed final contour levels, including works to stabilise the slopes fronting the site boundary. Infilling of the existing quarry void will continue. An area of OMH will be restored through placement of stored soils (from Phase 1) into the area indicated.



Key
