The owner wants to remove the chimney stack and make various small, but totally inappropriate, other changes.

It's a superb building in the CA and, per David Griffiths 'Highfields a most handsome suburb' was built in 1851 with John Hirst, wool merchant, as its first owner.

We have copied Sebastian, as he makes the exact same points as we would favour, and so hopefully those thoughts have been taken into consideration before decisions are made.
