Comments

Compartment one is located immediately to the north of Howgate Road and to the southwest of railway bridge MVL3/61. The southwest boundary of the Network Rail owned land is taken to be a dilapidated post and rail fence. The compartment comprises a narrow woodland block, subject to TPO (17/78/W1). It is dominated by mature sycamore, with some regeneration. The understory is predominantly holly, hazel and elder. Young ash on site are currently exhibiting symptoms consistent with advanced ash dieback.

Comments

Compartment two is located immediately to the west of Holme Road and to the northwest of railway bridge MVL3/61. The northwestern boundary of the Network Rail owned land is taken to be a linear group of recently planted cypress, and a wooden post and rail at top of embankment to the west of this. Mixed species with goat willow dominating lineside. Bramble and self-set young sycamore in areas that have previously been cleared.
