I would like to object to this application. It's bad enough with the traffic that Whiterose catering causes with lorries and vans. Mosque times are horrendous, there is absolutely no parking anywhere even the footpaths are blocked that a pram can not get through.

Our local shop Quality food is blocked by mosque users who choose deliberately to block them because of the Mosque.

There is a busy road with buses, lorries, can and cars. The zebra crossing is constantly blocked on both sides by mosque users and sometimes passing by you miss people and children crossing. It's an accident waiting to happen.

The yellow lines that cost council and tax payers so much money is constantly blocked by mosque users and 1 low road. Buses are always late they have changed their times due to the traffic the mosque and Whiterose catering has caused. That has affected the locals who use the bus service.
