When it comes to education this mosque

The car park can only house 22 spaces at max due to 1 charging stations for every 10 spaces and 2 disable spots

It is not big enough now to house the traffic we currently have how will it be sufficient if the extension goes ahead.

We have Whiterose catering the wholesaler their deliveries come in lorries (that more often than not come together 2 or 3 lorries) block the road forcing the on coming traffic to go into the other lane.

We have the zebra crossing and yellow lines blocked and the mosque users everyday but nothing seem to be done by Kirklees about that for some reason.

The Kirklees planning policy is there to make sure no application is made to damage any community or its members,
