1- The building period of the dwellings, will produce an enormous amount of inconvenience to the road of Kingsley avenue,

Being a _____ will mean this will not only have an affect on my health being unable to sleep due to the noise but also will cause trouble with trucks coming in and out of such a narrow road.

2- Health. I suffer from _____ which is triggered by any type of dust. With the chances of living next to a building site I feel is very unsuitable but also very dangerous for my condition. Once these house are built the community does not gain any benefit other than a lot more strain and problems. The area of Thornton lodge/crosland moor and lockwood is already a very built up area in which we struggle with, having more houses will not ease any pressure.

This is unfair on the house prices at Kingsley avenue from being a quiet road to a busy side street becoming.

If the houses were to be built and people with conditions similar to mine were in the situation of having to move out of the local area this would be a huge problem in todays crisis especially with inflation and interests rates it leaves residents no option but to suffer the pain.

I hope you will take into considerations every reason these dwellings are not suitable to be built behind 18 Kingsley Avenue.
