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Dear Planning Committee


I am emailing you in regards to the application submitted from 18 Kingsley Avenue, Huddersfield to erect 10 buildings. I am objecting to the planning which has been brought forward. As we can see from the Network Rail response, it would not be appropriate for this to go ahead due to possible dangers posed to the safety of the rail tracks.

I would also like to draw your attention to the existing infrastructure challenges in the vicinity, particularly the proposed road, Kingsley Avenue. Currently, this road is already narrow and constrained, with limited space for maneuvering due to a cul-de-sac configuration. The residents of Kingsley Avenue already face significant parking difficulties, as cars are parked along the entire road, leaving little room for passing vehicles. Approving the construction of 10 additional buildings would only exacerbate this problem, leading to further congestion, reduced accessibility, and potential safety hazards. Due to this bins have not been collected on multiple occasions. Complaints have already been put into the council in regards to the missed bin collections in the past.

There have been some 'residents' who have claimed there is a lot of rubbish at the proposed site. You will see from the pictures attached (obtained from Google maps) it clearly shows NO rubbish/litter on this land. The only littering we can see from these pictures is behind 18 Kingsley Avenue

I hope the council takes the right decision and rejects the planning proposal.
