A request has been received – Letter ref. 151667-TSA-00-TRU-REP-W-EN-900098v2, Dated 29 January 2026, to vary standard working hours in relation to works at Calder Road, Ravensthorpe. The works are required due to the delay in starting works at Calder Road, as a result of the commitment that Network Rail will not close Thornhill Road and Calder Road simultaneously

It has been confirmed that during these periods there is a highway closure on this section Calder Road, consented under Article 16 of the Transport and Works Act Order, agreed through the Highways Network Management Group. Given that Calder Road will be closed during the extended working hours and that an approved diversion will be in place HDM have no objection to the proposed extended working hours.
