The drawings that are submitted to us for inclusion within the S104 Agreement should be numbered the same as detailed above. If the drawing numbers are changed with no material changes relating to the design please ensure that a note is included within the revision table - 'This plan No..... is the same as the Technically Accepted (Plan No.....), but the reference number has changed to allow issue to site'. If there are any fundamental changes to the Technically Accepted drawings, then these alterations will need to be fully assessed and accepted before the S104 Agreement will be entered into.

SUPERVISION FEE

YOU WILL RECEIVE AN INVOICE FOR ANY PAYMENTS APPLICABLE – PLEASE DO NOT PAY UNTIL THIS IS RECEIVED

1. The estimated cost of the sewers to be adopted is **£212,150.00**. The 2.5% supervision fee is therefore **£5303.75**. The developer will be invoiced for this sum and any administration fees due shortly.
2. I confirm receipt of the 2.5% supervision fee **£500** for the adoptable sewer works has been paid and received.
3. A charge of **£178** is required for each private connection onto the public sewer(s) (including new adoptable sewer connections to the public sewers). This charge is additional to the 2.5% supervision fees charged by Yorkshire Water for supervision of the adoptable sewer works.
4. On receipt of the complete 'Request Form to Prepare Engrossed Agreements' I will prepare the Section 104 Agreement. There will be an administration charge of **£279** (to include up to three parties to the Agreement). This will be invoiced to the developer.
5. Yorkshire Water reserve the right to recover any additional costs in accordance with our Charging Arrangements 2022/23. Please ensure that all amendments are completed and details provided in your next submission. Due to additional checking of the submission, charges are levied against this application. These charges are **£154** (£77 per hour).

BOND

I understand that the developer wishes to deposit a 'Cash Bond' of £21,215.00 (Bond value of 10% of the cost of the works or minimum of £5,000) for the prospectively adoptable sewers in the Section 104 Agreement. ***Please note that the Section 104 Agreement will only be completed once the Cash Bond has been received.***

PRE START INSPECTION MEETING

In accordance with the Code for Adoption (2021), you must now request a **Pre Start Inspection Meeting** with one of our site inspectors. Sewer construction works should not commence on site for the adoptable assets detailed in the Technically Accepted drawings listed above until this meeting has been held.

To arrange a meeting, please complete, sign and return the Request Form (link below) for a Pre Start Inspection Meeting, along with all relevant information including all Health and Safety documents. On receipt of this, we will be pleased to arrange a convenient time for the meeting. The Developer Services inspector at the meeting will be your dedicated point of contact throughout the construction phase of this site.

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Under the provisions of Section 111 of the Water Industry Act 1991 it is unlawful to pass into any public sewer (or into any drain or private sewer communicating with the public sewer network) any items likely to cause damage to the public sewer network interfere with the free flow of its contents or affect the

treatment and disposal of its contents. Amongst other things this includes construction materials. Contravention of the provisions of Section 111 is a criminal offence.

Please note any approval under Sections 104 or 106 of the Water Industry Act 1991 is not an acceptance in respect to any planning conditions imposed under the Grant of Planning permission. The actual drainage conditions have been set via Yorkshire Water's Land and Planning team. Written confirmation from this team is required detailing the allowable discharge rates from the site which is still outstanding.
