This land has been a builders yard etc for many years. I personally rented the large wooden building & land at the side from _____ way back in 1968.

I was a coal merchant at the time and operated as Rowbottom & Glover we kept our coal lorry in the large wooden building from October 1968 for around 3 years.

I regularly had coal tipped on the land at the yard and we bagged it up for deliveries around Honley and Holmfirth.

My good friend _____ lived in the farm across the road and we also delivered his coal and got our eggs and milk from him for years.

The Builders Yard that _____ had been there well before I rented the wooden building on this land.

A friend of mine told me that councilmen we're trying to stop him spreading cow manure on this land, people move into small villages and try to stop what happens for years and years.

At the time I lived at 15 Stoney Lane, Rowndway, Honley. I've lived in and around Honley and Holmfirth all my life I was even the owner of the Railway Pub at Honley traffic light for many years.
