I consider there will be an issue regarding cooking odours, emanating from this proposed development. How will this issue be managed ? The property in question is at the bottom of Lewisham Road and faces the pedestrian crossing on Carr Lane, close to the circular car park. Parking is already at a premium within the village, this development will increase the frequency of traffic in this specific area. Traffic travelling west along Carr Lane, does not slow down sufficiently now. With traffic converging from New Street and from the car park, the risk to pedestrians will increase. The general state of the roads and lack of drain cleaning within the village is a huge concern. Surface water cannot escape via drains on Lewisham Road, due to those drains being clogged up with spent tarmac, etc. How will these drains be affected by the proposed increase in use from this development ? Virtually every day, I witness drivers driving up Lewisham Road, it is a one way street but the signs indicating such, are ignored. With this proposed development, this action could increase. How will access & parking be managed for the residents on Lewisham Road ? Also, how will existing businesses, for example, the post office, maintain their services for customers ? The community in the village & surrounding areas have lost the convenience and services of Lloyd's Bank since it's closure. They now rely on the services provided by the post office. Physical access to the post office for pedestrians & drivers is essential.
