**Discharge of Drainage Conditions**

- No. 4 (Foul & SW Drainage)
- No. 7 (Temporary Drainage)
- No. 8 (Oil Separator)
- No. 22 (YW Easement Condition – **to be discharged by YW**)
- No. 25 (Piped discharge – allowable SW flow rate)

**Drainage Summary:**

The LLFA confirms acceptance of the following:

- allowable surface water discharge rate of **13.1 l/s**,
- the proposed attenuation structure and volume,
- the hydraulic calculations submitted in the Drainage Assessment
- the exceedance flood routing,
- the proposed discharge point to the Yorkshire Water 375mm dia Combined Sewer in Scott Lane.

**Condition 4 & Condition 25**

The LLFA confirms that this condition **can be** discharged.

**Condition 7**

No details of how the site will be drained during the construction phase have been submitted, therefore this condition **cannot be** discharged.

**Condition 8**

The planning permission Decision Notice states that the drainage from the road should pass through an oil separator without roof water as this can flush out contaminants within the separator during periods of heavy rainfall. Therefore the road gullies shown on the Drainage Layout should discharge to a separate piped drain and through the separator prior to connection to the flow control chamber.

The developer should revise the Drainage Layout to address the above issue and re-submit the details. Therefore this condition **cannot be** discharged.
