

**Consultation Response from KC, Conservation & Design****2023/93173 Huddersfield Railway Station, St George's Square, Huddersfield, HD1 1JB****Listed Building Consent for installation temporary installation of artworks****Date Responded: 30.1.2024****Responding Officer: Sue Brooks****Responding Ref: HUD 1/33**

The installation of six pieces of temporary artwork is proposed at the northern end of Platform 1 at the Grade I listed Huddersfield Station. At the present time there are several modern planters in this location, and the applicant proposes to remove four of these.

The proposed artworks are fixed to new concrete foundations on the platforms and will have no impact on the historic fabric or significance of the station buildings and structures. Sited in front of a small ancillary station building at the northern end of the platform, they will have a slight visual impact on the setting of this structure, however there is also a large cycle shelter in this location and therefore the impact is negligible.

As the proposed installation is temporary, the Conservation and Design Team has no objections. The applicant has informally confirmed that they will be removed when the new footbridge is installed or when they have degraded to such a degree that they are no longer a viable art display. We would recommend that a time period is specified, with the platform made good once they are removed. If they impact on the wider TRU works, they should be removed to enable this work to be carried out.
