The Trees located within and surrounding the proposed work site are not protected under a TPO or a Conservation area.

The level of information submitted with the application is very detailed and thorough. Although there are a couple of category C and B tree's to be removed the affect on the wider site is minimal plus along with the new tree and hedge planting proposed there should be no long term affect on the wider area. The tree protection plan and the arboricultural monitoring for the Forest school are sufficient to ensure the protection of all retained trees during construction. All the Information provided is in line with BS5837 and there are no objections from a trees perspective.
