We wish to object strongly to this application for the following reasons;

In the previous application for this site, it was stated that all vehicles leaving this site shall have their wheels & chassis cleaned before entering the public highway. This has certainly not been adhered to & the tarmaced section of Cartworth Moor Rd. on wet days, is a slippery dangerous mess. All the silt & silica, plus diesel from waggon movements is being washed into the river Ribble.

This must be killing any fish & wildlife.

The applicants old planning application stated that 8 lorries in & 8 lorries out per day was allowed. Several day before Christmas 2023, a resident logged vehicle movement between 7.30am & 4.30pm. This was recorded as 25 lorries in, 20 lorries out. There have been lorries sighted earlier than this & up to 9pm. The vehicles have damaged both the verges & road surfaces, of which is damaging wildlife, flora & fauna. This extend`s all the way up to Barebones Rd. from the quarry. The none tarmaced section of

Cartworth Moor Rd., used to attract, walkers, runners, horseriders cyclists on a daily basis. Due to the damaged condition of this section, it is no longer safe for any of these activities .The applicant tried to repair this section during the summer of 2023, with crushed concrete that had plastic netting contained in it, which can still be seen. The footpath/bridleway from the quarry down to Whitegate Rd. is now unuseable, due to dangerous dogs, & the fear of by the owner, most of which has gone unreported due to the fear of retribution. No horse rider would knowingly use this bridleway.

The deepening of the quarry, excavating former fill, & storing soil above permitted levels, has already been carried out!!-hence retrospective application! Due to the fact of the steepness of spoil, large rocks & boulders are tumbling down onto Whitegate Rd., taking down the drystone walls in the process. It is only a matter of time before someone is injured or worse. We have had to move several out of the the road. This has been reported to Kirklees several times with NO RESPONSE!

During the summer months, the applicant has been working the crusher late into the evening, Saturday afternoons & all day Sundays. The noise & drone is not very pleasant!

If this application is passed, would Kirklees Council police all these misdemeanours which certainly HAS NOT HAPPENED TO DATE!
