The development of the site is not only on of natural beauty but one of historical significance. The current plans while taking into consideration the gate lodge does not unfortunately include the current and original reception building and Venue. It is disappointing to see such architecture with important local historical context be destroyed rather than redeveloped. The current site shop in the reception building could be used as a shop space or developed into housing space, while the recent success of the Venue could potentially continue.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• There seems to be significant loss or tress in the area in favour of overcrowded housing.• Football and Hockey teams currently heavily rely on parking at the student accommodation, it is not uncommon for between 50 and 100 cars on some evenings and weekends. Some events create significant congestion.• Storthes Hall Lane should reduce to 30mph between the proposed access points, currently there is no speed monitoring and drivers often exceed 40mph.• Access at the bottom of Storthes Hall Lane onto Penistone Road is very limited and does not work well under heavy traffic.
