<p>George Street is already an over-crowded street which is dangerous for both car users and those walking down the street. At the bottom of the road is a childcare setting which is already difficult to access due to the volume of cars that park on that street from the other businesses. Often cars are parked opposite each other denying access down the road causing people to have to park on the main road. The volume of traffic on this road is already excessive. The road is already dangerous for people commuting on foot, from having to dodge cars and mainly walk down the middle of the road as the pavements are blocked with cars. Again, extremely dangerous with the number of young children on the street and for pushchair users. When this business was operating in 2023 this street was made even more dangerous and the cars that they had meant there was no parking for those attending the childcare setting. Question, where would the cars be worked on by this garage be kept if there is already inadequate space? I am also extremely concerned about the pollution and the impact of having a mechanical garage in such close proximity to a childcare setting and how this could effect a childs health, especially a setting that is a 'forest nursery' and actively promotes outdoor play for children to explore and develop. The noise disturbance from the garage would also be a concern, again this would impact the children at the childcare setting and for a child with noise / SEND issues could be very detrimental. I believe that the pollution and noise would cause issues for the childcare setting and impact the wellbeing of the children that attend.</p>
