<p>Already being used as a garage, with blatant disregard to planning laws, health and safety, residents and existing established businesses. This has caused chaos to both George Street, and William Street, as local residents have nowhere to park, due to numerous abandoned cars. Already had two untaxed vehicles towed away by DVLA, which were left abandoned on William Street, long term, which were preventing residents from parking.</p> <p>Spare land between George Street and William Street, is packed with various abandoned vehicles.</p> <p>Access to the children's nursery, refuse collections and emergency services are all severely restricted, and pedestrians with children, having to walk in the middle of the road.</p> <p>Cars now overflow onto William Street, blocking the garage, gates, and car park, of the funeral business, preventing 24 hour access, despite clear road markings to keep clear.</p> <p>I've had police out on various occasions when our business access has been obstructed by vehicles, and if you ask people to move them, you usually get threatened, or a torrent of abuse.</p> <p>All caused by residents having nowhere to park, due to the number of additional and abandoned vehicles that have suddenly appeared, since this garage commenced business.</p> <p>Business should be shut down immediately by court order, pending result of planning application, and enquiries made with HMRC, as this doesn't appear to be a legitimate business, , and checks should be made to see if business operators have the necessary business insurance and public liability, t , if they're conducting business, not in accord with planning laws, health and safety, and all that goes with running a proper business.</p> <p>Please take note before someone gets hurt, as pavements are being obstructed.</p>
