<p>It has planning permission to be Storage shed, On the 18th August 2023 they started to place ramps inside to convert into a garage. The parking situation got worse for the local community and George street. The sign for Tee Motors went up on the 21st August 2023, we raised our concerns ever since to the planning office and still continue to do so. They have chopped down trees that were on the boarder of the property to make it bigger with out checking with the council again for permission. I have witnessed them block the road off with vehicles and parents waiting to drop the children off or collect them, i have heard car horns been blasted as they want to get past. I have seen the repair a van on the road down George street and this could have resulted in a very dangerous situation, were no emergency services being able to get down.</p> <p>They say some cars are not theirs parked near the nursery and then have been seen moving them, as it is very tight at the bottom and some parents find it hard to turn around.</p> <p>Also, on some occasions our trade waste has not been emptied as the bin truck could not get down, this has been an on going situation. which causes a very unclean environment for all.</p> <p>We have had parents on a daily basis inform us of situations of confrontations and in front of their children which is very upsetting as the nursery has been part of the local community for a long time.</p> <p>Also, I have seen the current opening time for the garage and the lights and doors have been open before 7am a few times this week., week commencing 29th Jan 2024. We are concerned of the knock on effect it will have on the nursery, for the local community.</p>
