





Introduction

This application is for the erection of 6 floodlights which illuminate an existing manege at Shaley Farm. The application is retrospective. The purpose of this statement is to describe the lights and explain their use.

The Proposals

The location of the lights is shown on the plan and aerial view below. The location of the lights is shown dotted.




The photographs below show the appearance of the lights. They consist of single lights mounted on 6m high galvanised steel lampposts.



The Use

The lights are used to illuminate the outside riding area which is used in connection with the livery. The stable yard closes at 8-30 at night and the lights are turned off at that time. Obviously during the summer months they are not used at all.

Public Visibilty



Views from the west and south are blocked by the topography of the hill.

These are the nearest dwellings to the lights that it is not within the farmholding. Views of the lights are blocked by the farm buildings.

Conclusions

The lights are used in connection with an existing approved use and are needed in connection with that business. They are not visible from any public areas and do not operate in unsociable hours. We consider that they can be granted planning permission.
