

Heritage Statement

The property is part of a Grade II 19th century listed barn in the hamlet of Hall Ing, converted to two residential dwellings by John Marsden in 1995 (Nos. 1 & 2 The Barn).

No. 2 The Barn has barn arches to the front and back of the property with original beams to the upper two floors.

Additionally three beams obtained from a local mill were installed to the lower two floors when the property was converted in 1995. One of these beams is supported by a concrete block wall which is not part of the original structure and separates the current kitchen and dining room.

It is proposed that this wall is removed, and a new structural support installed in the form of a 125mm x 125mm hardwood pillar in-keeping with the character of the property. This would open up the room and bring in light to the property.
