Reference to BGS indicates that the Coal field curtilage of the former CAPHOUSE Mine (now the YORKSHIRE MINING MUSEUM , EXTENDS ON AN EAST-WEST AXIS along the ridge between Middlestown and Overton and there are no workings to the north across the valley of Smithy Brook, the watercourse which separates Edge Road and Thornhill Edge.
