To whom it may concern,

We have estimated that the total volume of waste produced, divided between food, residual, recycling waste and fat/oil, will be less than 1100 L. We will therefore hire 1x660 L recycling bin, 1x360 L residual waste bin, 1x240L food waste and 1x60 L container for oil and fat from businesswaste.co.uk (quote attached below). These would be collected on a weekly basis. These bins would be located to the rear of the building, as indicated on the attached updated map. This position would maintain ease of access for bin collectors but remain hidden from the view of customers and passers-by.

In addition, we will build a wooden enclosure that will contain the bins, with a tall fence around the area, secured with a lock and code. This would further mitigate the sight of the bins for local residents and secure the bins against any pests. We will liaise with the contractors to ensure access to the bin store on collection days (we will supply them with the code to the lock). We have carefully read the Kirklees Waste Management Design Guide 2020 and would ensure that the enclosure complies with all regulations, in addition to the Building Regulations 2010 part H6. The designated area has suitable drainage, is in a shaded, hidden area, and is spacious enough to ensure easy access and cleaning. The designated area is also less than 10m away from the road, where the refuse collection agents would stop. This area would be cleaned on a regular basis.

In addition, to account for customer waste, we would position a 50L customer bin next to the building, as indicated on the updated map. This would be easily accessible to customers, but removed from the thoroughfare leading to the nook etc. This bin would be emptied on a daily basis, or whenever it reaches capacity, into the bins behind the building. This bin will be securely stored within the bin shed at the end of the day. The business intends to recycle the majority of its waste, which would mainly comprise of packaging and recyclable customer utensils, such as plates, spoons and forks and napkins.

I have been assured that bins from businesswaste.co.uk would meet all fire and health and safety requirements, in plastic bins. Obviously, we cannot commit to a contract until after planning permission has been secured, but we intend to move ahead with this contract if we do.
