<p>Adding such large houses to the already saturated green belt land that Shepley has is an increasing concern, not just to the surrounding houses or increasing population of the village but to the safety of the village.</p> <p>Marsh Lane which is a 30mph speed limit is already experiencing not just an increase in traffic but the speed at which people drive at. Increasing the amount of cars and footfall this area has will only increase the risk of further accidents.</p> <p>As a parent of two young children, I am not fond of walking up and down this busy road and if planning is approved things will only get worse.</p> <p>The plans also clearly demonstrate that the boundaries will be imposing on the gardens of the already existing houses which if I lived in close proximity of the new builds would be furious with the invasion of my families privacy.</p> <p>Shepley and the surrounding areas of rural Huddersfield are what make this area so appealing and anything additional to the area should add value to the locals and those who live there, this addition in my opinion does not.</p> <p>Finally, Shepley first school is already oversubscribed and clearly can't accommodate the current population leading to locals now having to attend schools outside of the area when they live so close which is ridiculous.
