<p>50 new houses will result in 100 or more asdditional motor vehicles which will be exiting the new estate onto a country road. It is expected that the majority of these vehicles will be moving out from and into the estate at "Rush Hours". Shepley Rd is already as busy road at Rush Hour and the corner where the exit for the estate is planned is hazardous. The route from Shepley through Stocksmoor, Thurstonland , Farnley Tyas and Almondberry is a well used short cut into Huddersfield for traffic from the South particularly at Rush Hour. The route is marginally shorter than the Main road via Waterloo and is much quicker missing out the congestion from Waterloo into Town. Not all the new traffic will be going into Huddersfield, some will be going South towards Shepley, Sheffield, Barnsley and Wakefield. At rush hour these vehicles will be travelling Counterflow to the predominant flow towards (or from) Huddersfield. The road to Shepley is narrow with several dangerous corners and accidents are not infrequent even without the additional traffic from the new estate.</p> <p>I consider that the additional traffic resulting from building 50 new homes will create serious hazard on the road within Stocksmoor itself and on the country lane to Shepley.</p> <p>I perfectly understand the need to build new homes and that the proposed site may be sensible for some houses (say 10-15) but I consider that even a half of the proposed number of houses would still constitute a serious road hazard.</p>
