<p>I do not believe that building 50 houses would benefit the local area, due to it causing destruction of part of Stone's Wood, as well as being built in an area not designed for large traffic numbers, which 50 new houses would bring. This would be most apparent on Shepley Rd, heading towards Shepley, which is almost completely single track. To add to this, an increased number of cars and people would disrupt local wildlife populations, such as the deer that have been spotted within the wood. As well, many facilities and services in the Shepley and Stocksmoor area do not have the necessary capacity to support an extra 50 local households, making people have to travel further for goods and services, which necessitates more greenhouse gases in the air, further hurting our local environment.</p> <p>I would also like to object to this proposal as a stance against future developments in our local area. We are lucky to be surrounded by the beautiful countryside, and by allowing this development, it may open the gateway to allow for further housebuilding in this area, which would exacerbate problems already outlined in this objection, as well as ruining the natural beauty of the local area.</p>
