This is clearly not a sustainable location! Public transport in the village is very poor, I have given up trying to use it to visit, as it is so infrequent and unreliable. The proposed development will cause an increase in traffic, at least another 100 cars in the village, and as there are no schools or even a shop, every journey is by car. The traffic assessment is completely incorrect, you cannot walk to any local amenities from Stocksmoor and getting on your bike is taking your life in your hands, only the highly experienced cyclists would tackle Stones Wood Lane, Birks Lane or Damm Hill. It is quite an isolated village and I think that is why so many people visit for the pleasure of walking and enjoying the ancient woodland and wildlife there.</p>
