<p>I object to this proposal for many reasons, but my main reason is the increase in traffic that this will bring. Stocksmoor does not have good public transport links, the trains are once an hour at best and there is sometimes a bus (every two hours) to Huddersfield, which is pretty useless to those of us who work in Leeds and Wakefield. The majority of us commuting will head towards Shepley (using the highly unsuitable Stones Wood Lane) to access the motorway network - it is the shortest/fastest route by a long way and it is the way that any sat nav will send you. As there are no schools, shops, GP in Stocksmoor, every journey has to be made by car. The often single-track roads serving the village simply cannot cope with more cars and the many walkers who visit the village are being put at risk.</p> <p>I have concerns about the drainage and water run off, as there are already issues in the village with this. I also have concerns about the impact on the wildlife in the field, as it adjoins Stones Wood.</p>
