<p>As a Shepley resident working in Huddersfield I sometimes have to cut through Stone Wood to Stocksmoor. In recent times I have struggled to do this due to the amount of other people doing this in both directions and the single track road simply cannot handle the traffic with very few passing places. Adding 50 houses is going to see many of these cutting through Stone Wood lane to commute to Sheffield, Wakefield, Leeds towards M1 via Shepley and this is going to make Stone Wood Lane a congested single track road. I have seen horses and cyclists not be able to pass vehicles on this land. I have seen litter volunteers due to the amount of use this tiny scenic lane is now getting.</p> <p>When I walk my dog along Stone Wood Lane I am constantly having to step into the ditch to avoid passing traffic which now also included DPD deliveries, grocery firms like Asda using the route. Adding 50 houses directly onto this tiny lane is going to damage the local feel of the area being a once quiet lane you could walk or cycle down.</p> <p>I also think this greenbelt area, where people have chosen to live here due to the rural feel and quietness, is going to be damaged by noise pollution along with the site of 50 concrete houses adjacent to peaceful woodland. There are plenty of brownfield sites such as old mills in our area that could be converted to housing without natural beauty and peace being destroyed.</p>
