ALL the roads leading to and from Stocksmoor are very narrow many of them including Shepley Road, Stone Wood Lane, Birks Lane, Dam Hill, Grange Lane, Wood Lane are basically Cart tracks that have been tarmaced

These roads are far too narrow and are already very busy with traffic using them as a rat run during peak times, an additional 100+ vehicles would be extremely dangerous.

Stocksmoor is a small village 50 new homes will drastically change its appearance

Can the existing schools accommodate this increase in children??

Can the GP surgeries accommodate this increase

Can the existing sewage system cope, I know the system that flows down into Thunderbridge cannot for every time it rains the sewage system blocks and overflows onto the road and then seeps into Shepley Dyke.
