<p>I grew up in Stocksmoor and still have family in the village including my grandmother on Shepley Road. A small, rural village location - highly desirable for these reasons. I work as a local estate agent and understand the need for additional housing. However, I think this proposal is totally reckless. It would increase the size of the village by 30%! The single track road between Stocksmoor and Shepley simply will not cope with the traffic from these houses. We regularly walk from our home in Shepley to visit relatives in the village with our 1 year old daughter and it already feels unsafe & with 50 additional homes (circa 100 extra cars?) it feels totally irresponsible and will make the roads more unsafe & hazardous.</p> <p>The proposed entrance to the development is directly on the bend which is very dangerous. Speeding is evident in the village and the higher volume of traffic is likely to make this more severe. Local roads will not be able to cope.</p> <p>It will also put high levels of strain on already stretched/limited local amenities e.g. local schools, public transport.</p> <p>Also, due to the open aspect and nearby woodlands, it will effect the local wildlife which we thoroughly enjoy capturing when in the village.</p> <p>For these reasons I strongly object to these proposals.</p>
