The design of this site is well thought out with regards to the current tree population. The submitted arboricultural impact assessment is thorough and makes valid recommendations. The removal of T1, T2 and T3 to facilitate the access road to the site is a tolerable loss due to their category C classification. Also, the loss of these trees can be mitigated through the new planting suggested. The design is a sufficient distance from the ancient woodland to the east that there should be no impact whatsoever.

There are no objections to the proposals under the condition that a site-specific, arboricultural method statement is submitted to accurately show the steps that will be taken to ensure no trees are damaged or harmed during construction.
