<p>My main objection is the huge impact this will have to traffic increase, plus the traffic and highway safety issue. The proposed site entrance is on a tight, almost blind bend onto Shepley Road/Stone Wood Lane, which is a narrow road, mostly single lane. This is the main route to our local services and will not feasibly give regular access to another 50 plus vehicles. During the construction phase it would cause great disruption to the areas main access to local services, including schools, doctors, pharmacy and shops. Shepley Road/Stone Wood Lane and the junction of Cross Lane/Fulstone Road are not roadways designed for heavy plant movements, so the construction phase would cause numerous traffic issues and logistical nightmares for the roads locally. Stone Wood Lane is also a route regularly used by horse riders, walkers and cyclists (this route is on the National Cycle Network). To have another 50 plus cars driving through here daily would have a huge impact on highway safety. There will undoubtedly be an increase in traffic accidents.</p> <p>Also a building development of this scale, directly next to ancient woodland would have a devastating effect on the local wildlife.</p>
