<p>There is insufficient infrastructure in the area to support this amount of new homes / families. It is already nearly impossible to get an appointment at the Doctors surgeries in Kirkburton or Shepley and the local schools have very limited availability. The roads around Stocksmoor are narrow country lanes, which are single carriageway in many places and unsuitable for an increase in volume. There are no shops in Stocksmoor so residents will be forced to drive to one of the local villages, most likely either Kirkburton or Shepley both of which already have serious issues with the availability of parking spaces. The proposed point of access to the new development is on a corner on a narrow lane, this seems to be a very poor choice and will undoubtedly be dangerous. Ultimately this is a small village with individual homes, the new development will not be in keeping with the local area, and will produce noise and light pollution to the existing home owners. There must be better suited sites to a development of this scale, where there is sufficient access to a good road network and all other amenities needed for normal families.</p>
