<p>We strongly object to the proposed development.</p> <p>Access to and from the site will be onto the bend of a narrow lane with no footpath or street lighting towards Shepley.</p> <p>Public transport serving Stocksmoor is unreliable at best. Residents of the development WILL use their own transport, potentially 100 extra vehicles on surrounding narrow lanes placing pedestrians, cyclists and horse riders (who currently use the roads at their peril) in even greater danger.</p> <p>The nearest shop is in Shepley along with the already stretched health centre, dental surgery & school which will undoubtedly be accessed via Stones Wood Lane, a mostly single track lane with limited opportunities for vehicles to pass safely. This lane is already used as a "rat run" by peak time travellers to avoid right turns onto Penistone road from the other two options (Dam Hill & Birks Lane/ Thunderbridge Lane) which in turn causes increased traffic through the centre of Shepley</p> <p>The development will also have a detrimental impact on wildlife due to the destruction, noise and light pollution caused.</p>
