<p>30% increase in number of homes could equate to 50% increase in population (village), 40% increase in vehicles located in Stocksmoor. An estimated 50% increase in delivery vans using all the access roads including through Stones Wood and Fulstone road; routes frequently used by agricultural vehicles. Without major improvements to roads and pavements this planning proposal is not safe for the suggested journeys to access schools, doctors, pharmacies and grocers.</p> <p>The development of Storthes Hall and other sites within 3 miles will result in stressed essential services.</p> <p>Loss of habitat for a wide range of species around Stones Wood and the beck would be a significant loss to a much wider community who visit and value the natural tranquility for the opportunities to experience the countryside for their health and wellbeing.</p> <p>The plan and materials does not integrate into the existing village and the disproportionate size would overwhelm the local character creating a feeling of disharmony to the detriment of everyone living in the village including those who might live in this ill prepared development.</p> <p>These plans should not be approved</p>
