<p>You will note that I live very near Stocksmoor in the area of Thunderbridge and I think this will negatively impact on the area I am living in due to the fact there will be considerably more cars use the lane into Thunderbridge if planning goes ahead for another 50 houses in Stocksmoor village with a likelihood of at least 100 more cars and probably more taking into account the sizes of the houses which are intended to be built. The area going past the Woodman Public House is already congested with traffic and especially in the spring/summer months when weddings are taking place people are constantly having to stop their cars to let people pass from the pub across to the sitting out areas and to the other venue buildings across the road. Cars constantly have to move over to let other cars past. And for people who decide to go the other way up into Shepley on basically a single track road will create the same problems and possible accidents. If development was to go ahead the disruption for the village would be significant and would not bring any jobs into this area other than when the development was being built.
