This is a rural village, whose landscape and wildlife would suffer greatly should the building of this estate go ahead. How can this be a "sustainable development" . This land was supposed to be protected up until 2031 by Kirklees planning who have now gone back on their word to protect green space and environment. Our green areas are essential to stop "urban sprawl" out to the villages. Green space in other areas of Kirklees has been ruined - please consider building on areas which are brownfield first before destroying countryside.
