<p>I strongly oppose the proposed development for a number of reasons.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. This would increase the size of the village by approx, 30%.</li><li>2. The proposed entrance to the development is on a blind corner. It would not be possible to change this entrance to make it safe for pedestrians, children, cyclists or horse riders.</li><li>3. The nearest amenities are 1 mile away in Shepley, the most direct route to Shepley is through Stones Woods which is already unsuitable for the amount of traffic.</li><li>4. The Shepley Doctors are already struggling to cope with the amount of new patients.</li><li>5. The local catchment school is in Thurstonland, the school only takes an annual intake of 12 children. The school is already over subscribed without another 50 houses being build in the catchment.</li><li>6. The plans show 127 parking spaces in the new development, a high percentage of these vehicles will be travelling through Stones Wood, this is on the National Cycle Network and is also used by horse riders.</li><li>7. Stones Wood is notorious for accidents and incidents of road rage due to the amount of traffic travelling on a single tracked road.</li></ol>
