<p>1 Access point onto Shepley road totally unsuitable and should in my opinion never have been designated as "safeguarded land" for building on.</p> <p>2 Village infrastructure not suitable for such massive expansion, no local doctors and schools, even those nearby can not cope with present numbers. Gave up trying to get anywhere reliably on time by train as it is often cancelled. There are many brownfield sites in kirklees that could be developed before considering an area that should be designated as green belt.</p> <p>3 The said field supports a wealth of native wildlife, I have seen Roe deer, Hares and hunting owls to name but a few making it a precious community asset, it is not suitable for such mass development.</p> <p>4 Even if a smaller development were allowed elsewhere in the village it needs to be in keeping with the existing village look (eg Stocksmoad built of soft natural or even reclaimed stone),not this very basic design and certainly not three story.</p>
